Terms of Order made by the Court by Consent

Pleadings

1. The Plaintiff have leave to file and serve its amended commercial list statement in the form provided to the defendant on 16 July 2019, and its amended summons in the form provided to the Defendant on 8 August 2019 (the Amended Pleadings) by 9 August 2019.
2. The Plaintiff to respond to the Defendant's request for further and better particulars of the Amended Pleadings by 29 August 2019.
3. The Defendant to file and serve is Commercial List Response to the Amended Pleadings by 27 September 2019.

Notice to Group Members

4. The Plaintiff is to provide the Defendant with its draft opt out notice pursuant to section 175(1)(a) of the Civil Procedure Act 2005 (NSW), and
 - a. draft orders with the respect to the proposed manner and timing of giving the opt out notice;
 - b. information as to the anticipated costs of giving the opt out notice in the manner proposed; and
 - c. draft orders as to the payment of costs of giving the opt out notice if not to be borne by the representative party,by 23 August 2019 (the Draft Opt Out Notice).
5. The Defendant is to indicate whether it consents or proposes any changes to the Draft Opt Out Notice by 6 September 2019.

Common Fund Application

6. By 6 September 2019, the Plaintiff is to file and serve on the Defendant an application seeking a 'common fund' order (Common Fund Application).
7. The matter be listed for further directions on 4 October 2019.
8. Liberty to restore on 3 days' notice.
