- 1. Categories 1(a),(b),(c),(d),(e),(f) and (g) according to the search terms there identified, together with the additional search words which the plaintiff notifies the defendant in writing by 9 July 2021.
- 2. Categories 2(a),(i),(ii),(iii) and (iv), provided the plaintiff has by not later than 9 July 2021, paid to the defendants \$200,000 to represent the costs of review. If the costs of review are less than \$200,000 the defendants are to refund the difference to the plaintiff. The amount so paid (subject to final assessment in either direction) will be costs in the cause. The defendants are to refund to the plaintiff the amount by which the amount paid exceeds final assessment.
- 3. Categories 2(a),(v),(vi) and (vii) provided the plaintiff has by not later than 9 July 2021, paid to the defendants a further \$200,000 to represent the costs of review.
