The Honourable Justice D Yehia is seeking expressions of interest to fill the role of her Honour's Associate in 2023. The role will commence in April 2023, for a minimum term of two years.

Description of Role

The Associate position provides broad and high-level executive support to enable her Honour to meet obligations both within the court and to external stakeholders, including legal practitioners and litigants. The Associate is responsible for managing her Honour's Chambers and is the first point of contact for all members of the public and profession. The role also encompasses assisting her Honour with complex legal research, drafting, and incourt duties.

Essential Skills

Candidates interested in applying for this position must display the following essential skills and abilities:

- Completion of a law degree;
- Completion of Practical Legal Training;
- Experience in an administrative and/or managerial role;
- Highly developed legal research, conceptual and analytical skills;
- Excellent organisational and multi-tasking skills;
- Strong interpersonal skills;
- Attention to detail.

Desired Skills

Although not essential, the following skills and abilities are highly desirable:

- Understanding of and/or experience with court practices and procedures;
- Understanding of and/or experience with JusticeLink;
- Interest in criminal law and advocacy;
- Involvement in extracurricular activities and voluntary work in legal areas.
