- 5. If the Defendants consent to the draft Second Further Amended Statement of Claim, the Plaintiffs have leave to file it by Tuesday 26 October 2021.
- 6. If the Plaintiffs consent to the draft amended defences, the Defendants have leave to file them by Tuesday 26 October 2021.
- 7. If a party does not consent to any other party filing an amended pleading, the party wishing to amend its pleading is to file a notice of motion seeking leave to file its amended pleading by Tuesday 2 November 2021.
